

## **CHAPTER VIII. OVERVIEW OF EMERGENCY-DEPARTMENT DATA AND CHARGES**

This section of the report provides detailed information collected about visits to emergency departments (EDs) in Wisconsin hospitals.

### **Facilities that Reported Data**

Data were collected from 126 hospitals on ED visits between January 1, 2017, and December 31, 2017. Most (125) of these hospitals are general medical-surgical hospitals.

The ED visits summarized in this report are those in which patients came to the ED, received evaluation and/or treatment, and were discharged from the ED. Excluded from this analysis are cases in which the patient was admitted as an inpatient from the ED or were held over for observation. Also excluded are those in which the patient underwent an ambulatory surgery procedure (such cases are reported in Chapter VI)

Wisconsin hospitals reported a total of 1,844,060 ED visits in 2017.

### **How to Read the Tables**

Tables 32 through 43 summarize the volume and types of ED visits in Wisconsin in 2017.

Table 32 presents the number and rate of Wisconsin ED visits by patient age and gender:

- Seventeen percent of all ED visits involved a child less than 15 years old.
- Fifty-six percent of all ED visits involved female patients.
- Males and females 85 years and older had the highest visit rates among all age/gender categories, at 58 and 54 per 100 population respectively.

Table 33 examines the number and percentage of Wisconsin ED visits by type of primary diagnosis, by age and gender:

- Twenty-one percent of all ED visits were related to injury and poisoning diagnoses.
- Twenty-five percent of all male ED patient visits were related to injury and poisoning.

Table 34 presents the number and percentage of the most frequently reported primary diagnoses by age group:

- Seventy-seven percent of all middle ear and mastoid ED primary diagnoses were for children under age 15.
- Twenty-one percent of all injuries to the ankle and foot ED primary diagnoses were for patients aged 15 – 24.
- Eighty-one percent of all mental disorder ED primary diagnoses were for patients aged 25 – 64.
- Thirty-two percent of all urinary disease ED primary diagnoses were for patients aged 65 and older.

Tables 35 through 40 present greater detail about the number and percentage distribution for the most frequently reported primary diagnoses for each age group, by gender.

Tables 41 and 42 present the number and percentage of injury-related ED visits by external cause codes statewide and by age group. Table 41 indicates that the most common types of injury treated in Wisconsin emergency departments in 2017 were those relating to falls. Fall-related injuries accounted for thirty-two percent of all the injury cases, at a rate of 2,324 per 100,000 population.

Table 42 shows the breakdown of ED visits by age. Falls were the most common injury-related diagnosis among Wisconsin ED visits in 2017 for children under 15, and for adults aged 25 and older. Among patients 15 – 24, the largest number of injury-related visits fell into the category of “striking/struck by.”

Table 43 lists the Wisconsin hospitals that reported ED visits for 2017 and the number of visits at each hospital. Not all hospitals operate emergency departments.

### **Caveats/Data Limitations for Emergency-Department Data**

1. Percentages are rounded to whole numbers.
2. Diagnoses were categorized according to the International Classification of Diseases, 10<sup>th</sup> Revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-10-CM). The Supplementary Classification category encompasses factors other than disease or injury, such as observation for a condition that was not found, removing sutures, and blood tests for alcohol or other drugs.
3. External cause code groups were categorized utilizing the methodology outlined in Appendix 2 – Methodology and Technical Notes. Visits were only considered to be injury or poisoning related if an external cause code (V00 through Y99) or poisoning diagnosis (T36-T65) was reported.
4. The visit rate is the number of visits per 100 or 100,000 population. The rate was calculated by dividing the total number of visits in a particular age, gender, or diagnosis category by the U.S. Census Bureau's 2017 population estimates for that age, gender, analysis area or statewide total, then multiplying the result by 100, or 100,000, as applicable.
5. Records were considered to be ED records for purposes of this report if
  - (a) they contained a revenue code in the 0450-0459 range, excluding 0456
  - (b) the patient was not admitted as an inpatient at the facility providing ED care
  - (c) the patient did not undergo an ambulatory surgery procedure
  - (d) The patient was not transferred to observation status.
