

Wisconsin Psychiatric Bed Locator – Administrator

One of the Wisconsin Hospital Association’s 2015-2016 legislative priorities was the creation of a *voluntary*, web-based Wisconsin Inpatient Psychiatric Bed Locator system to enable hospital emergency departments to see information about psychiatric bed availability to accelerate the transition of care from the ER to an available psychiatric inpatient bed. WHA Information Center (WHAIC) was contracted to develop and operate the system. The Bed Locator Tool has expanded to include crisis stabilization and peer run respite beds in 2021.

WHAIC designed a password-protected site to allow a psychiatric facility/unit to enter bed availability information, and to allow any general authorized user to view this information.

Facility admins will be asked to register to the Psychiatric Bed Locator to access the administration pages of the Bed Locator Tool. WHAIC staff will grant access as specified during the registration process with the facility’s primary contact authorization. Facilities may have as many users accessing the psychiatric unit administration system as they want.

To register on the WHAIC Portal:

All admins that will be updating psychiatric bed availability will be required to register for access to the Psychiatric Bed Locator if they do not already have access. - 2) To register, click the Psychiatric Bed Locator Login button and click “Register” below the “Login” button:



- 3) Enter your email address to determine if you already have an account on the WHAIC Portal.

- 4) If you do not have an existing account, please complete the registration form. After clicking “register,” you will receive a registration confirmation message online. You will receive an email to verify your email account.

- 5) If you are already an admin for a hospital(s) and you need to modify your access – adding or removing a hospital – please email whainfocenter@wha.org and WHAIC can make the updates for you.
- 6) After you verify your account, you can click the “login” button on the login page to access the Psychiatric Bed Locator.

How to update the Psychiatric Bed Locator – Administration Pages

This site is intended to provide data reporting for general authorized users across the state to locate services and serve as a resource for identifying availability of psychiatric beds.

- 1) Facilities are encouraged to update their potential bed availability at least every 8 hours. A facility/unit may update their availability more frequently if they choose.
- 2) Your facility can have as many users as needed to meet the reporting needs.

Once registration has been authorized, admins should log into the [Psychiatric Bed Locator](#) Admin page to update the number of beds available. After logging into the WHAIC Portal, click on “Psychiatric Bed Locator Admin.”

PSYCHIATRIC DASHBOARDS

In 2023, the WHA Information Center added new functionality that enables admins to see aggregate trends of psychiatric bed availability for their own facilities in the Psychiatric Bed Locator Tool. You can see the three dashboard available above the drop-down menu to select a hospital.

FACILITY SELECT PAGE

If you are responsible for more than one facility, select the facility from the drop-down menu, in which you are making changes or updating the number of psychiatric beds available. If you are responsible for only one hospital, you will not see the drop-down menu.

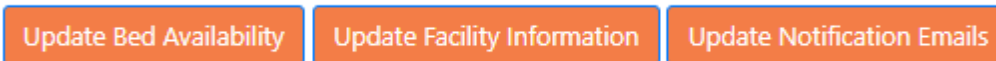

Admins will have three buttons displayed.



Use **Update Current Availability** to update the number of psychiatric beds that are currently Potentially Available for an Admission for each type of service your facility offers (Inpatient - Adult, Inpatient - Geriatric, Inpatient - Adolescent [Adolescents 12 to 18 years old], Inpatient - Child [under 12 years old], Adult Crisis Stabilization Facility, Youth Crisis Stabilization Facility, and Peer Run Respite Facility) and optional comments on admissions, acuity, etc.

Use **Facility Information** to provide phone numbers for Admission Contact(s), service area, insurance information or other additional information you wish to share with other users of the Bed Locator Tool.

Use **Email Notifications** if you would like your unit(s) to automatically receive email reminders if an update to the Psychiatric Bed Locator tool has not been made by your unit(s) in the past 24 hours.

UPDATE CURRENT AVAILABILITY

To help increase the utility of the Psychiatric Bed Locator Tool for authorized users seeking an inpatient psychiatry bed, a peer respite bed or a crisis stabilization bed, admins utilizing the Psychiatric Bed Locator Tool **are strongly encouraged to update their potential bed availability at least twice per day**

(encouraging to report once in the morning and once in the later afternoon/evening). Of course, a facility/unit may update their availability more frequently and/or when additional beds become potentially available for new admissions. It is up to the facility's discretion as to when and how often it chooses to update this information.

See information at the bottom of the page for the operational definition of "Bed Potentially Available for an Admission" and potential uses for the Comments field.

Click **Edit** to make changes to the number of Available Beds, and/or Comments and also the number of beds setup-and-staffed at the time of update. If this information has not changed since the last update, click **Update With No Changes**.

* A Bed Potentially Available for an Admission means a bed that is setup-and-staffed, but is unoccupied or not currently reserved at the time of update. Although a bed may be listed as potentially available, the bed may not be appropriate for all admissions as determined by the unit. Beds Potentially Available for an Admission are not guaranteed beds. In all cases, users of the Psychiatric Bed Locator must call the unit to discuss a potential admission.

** A facility/unit may wish to provide other information about its Beds Potentially Available for an Admission that would be useful to emergency department staff seeking a psychiatry bed. Examples might include: "Available bed is only for a femail at this time," "Non-violent only;" or "On waitlist for new admissions."
